Senior Years Scholarships

Faith Lutheran College offers scholarships to gifted and high-achieving students in the areas of Academic Excellence, Sport and Performing Arts.

Our Scholarship Program is designed to provide financial assistance to students in order to strengthen the quality of our educational programs.

Through our Senior Years Scholarships Program, we are proud to be able to offer these opportunities to both current and new students, with demonstrable achievement or potential in the areas of academic excellence or sport.

A limited number of scholarships in each area are made available on an annual basis, and all students are encouraged to apply.

Applications for Senior Years Scholarships generally open six (6) months before the students are due to commence, and close approximately nine (3) months before the students are due to commence. For example, students seeking to commence or continue Year 11 or Year 12 at the beginning of 2025 will be required to apply between July and of October of 2024.



Senior Years Scholarships: Application Guidelines

The following guidelines should be observed when preparing an application for a Senior Years Scholarship:

1. Parents/carers interested in applying for an academic scholarship for their student are requested to address the relevant selection criteria outlined for the chosen scholarship, and complete an Online Scholarship Application attaching any relevant documentation required.
2. In the interest of equal opportunities for all students, individual students may submit an application for consideration across multiple scholarship categories, however, each individual student will only be eligible to receive ONE scholarship in ONE area. The decision to offer a scholarship and the relevant area remains at the discretion of Faith Lutheran College.
3. Senior Scholarships are available to both new and existing students planning to commence or continue their Senior Years (Years 11 and 12) studies at Faith Lutheran College
4. Scholarship Applications from new (non-existing) students must either:
 - be accompanied by an Enrolment Application, or;
 - be submitted as an accompaniment to an Enrolment Application that is currently in process
5. In addition to the specific selection criteria for a given scholarship area, all Scholarship Applicants must be able to demonstrate a history of excellent behaviour and work ethic.
6. Scholarships may be awarded up to a maximum of 50% tuition fee remission.





Selection Criteria: Academic Scholarships

A limited number of Academic Scholarships: will be available to both new and existing students, commencing or continuing in Year 11 or Year 12 each school year, who can demonstrate exceptional academic achievement.

Academic Scholarships are awarded based on a combination of selection criteria, including:

- Scholarship examination* (administered on a date and time set by Faith Lutheran College)
- Academic reports
- Evidence of past student achievement and performance
- NAPLAN results
- An interview with a College representative
- Written reference

*Please note that the results of any Scholarship examination remain confidential, and are not disclosed to either students or parents/carers.

In deciding whether to offer a scholarship, the following factors are considered:

- Previous academic achievements in all areas;
- The applicant's commitment to focus on academic programs at the College; and,
- The applicant's commitment to upholding Faith Lutheran College's high standard in behaviour, scholarship and work habits.





Selection Criteria: Sports Scholarships

A limited number of Sports Scholarships will be available to both new and existing students, commencing or continuing in Year 11 or Year 12 each school year

While these Scholarships are awarded primarily on the basis of sporting or athletic ability, all scholarship recipients will be required to maintain their dedication to school sport at Faith whilst ensuring their level of academics matches their level of sporting achievement.

Prospective students may apply scholarship in the following categories:

1. General Sport Scholarship

Applicants demonstrate excellence in the fields of athletics, swimming, cross country, volleyball, basketball, soccer, netball, touch football, indoor cricket or AFL.

2. Total Rugby Scholarship

Applicants demonstrate excellence in the field of rugby union, rugby league or Rugby 7's.

Sports Scholarships are awarded based on a combination of selection criteria, including:

- Scholarship examination (administered on a date and time set by Faith Lutheran College)
- Sporting achievements in sports in which Faith Lutheran College competes at a high level
- Commitment to representing Faith Lutheran College across a range of sports and/or events.
- Academic reports
- The applicant's commitment to College strength and conditioning programs and mentor groups.
- The applicant's commitment to upholding the rights and responsibilities of a student at Faith Lutheran College.
- The applicant's commitment to upholding Faith Lutheran College's high standard in behaviour, scholarship and work habits.
- Written references





Applying for a Senior Years Scholarship

Applications for Senior Years Scholarships must be made online by visiting: www.faithlc.qld.edu.au/scholarships

1. Review the Selection Criteria

Ensure you have read through the relevant Selection Criteria for the type(s) of Scholarship you wish to apply for.

2. Prepare Supporting Documents

Prepare/Arrange to obtain any of the documents (in digital format) you may need to support your application. These may include:

- Evidence of the Student's achievement including awards, certificate and/or qualifications
- Written references from the Student's teacher, principal, deputy principal, head of curriculum or coach

3. Register with EduTest

Follow the links on the Faith Lutheran College website to register to sit the Senior Scholarship Test, facilitated by EduTest, and pay the relevant testing fee.

4. Apply Online

Visit: www.faithlc.qld.edu.au/scholarships and follow the prompts to Apply Online.

5. Attach Supporting Documents and Submit Application

Complete the Scholarship Application using the online form, ensuring that all relevant supporting documents are attached.

6. Complete an Enrolment Application

In order to be eligible for a Senior Years Scholarship, all Scholarship Applications must

- be submitted on behalf of a current student at Faith Lutheran College;
- or, in the case of new (non-current) students:
- be accompanied by an Enrolment Application
 - be submitted as an accompaniment to an Enrolment Application that is currently in process
